- This offer is available to people who have recently moved or started renting a property in Huntingdonshire and is open to new members of One Leisure only.
- 2. To apply for this offer you must have received your Council Tax bill and an enclosed flier to access the page via a link to apply for your One leisure pass.
- 3. The 7-day pass is available for anyone in your household to apply for and is valid for 7 consecutive days at any of the One Leisure sites and must start within a month of the date printed on the Council Tax bill for your new home.
- 4. Every member of the household will need their own 7-day pass, and this will be set up on a One Leisure account.
- 5. The 7-day pass entitles the member to use the centres on weekdays before 4.30pm and all weekend. The pass includes access to activities such as swimming, gym*, indoor cycling, off-peak court use and off-peak classes delivered across One Leisure, and in the community by Active Lifestyles. (Excludes peak time classes and badminton courts).
- 6. The membership is non-transferable.
- 7. Any personal data provided by and relating to members will not be disclosed to a third party without the individual's consent. Personal data relating to members will be retained by One Leisure for a reasonable period of time after the membership ends.
